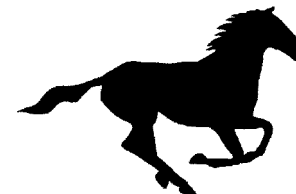

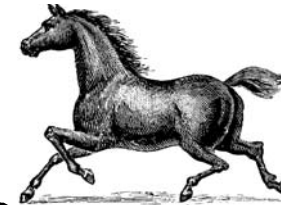

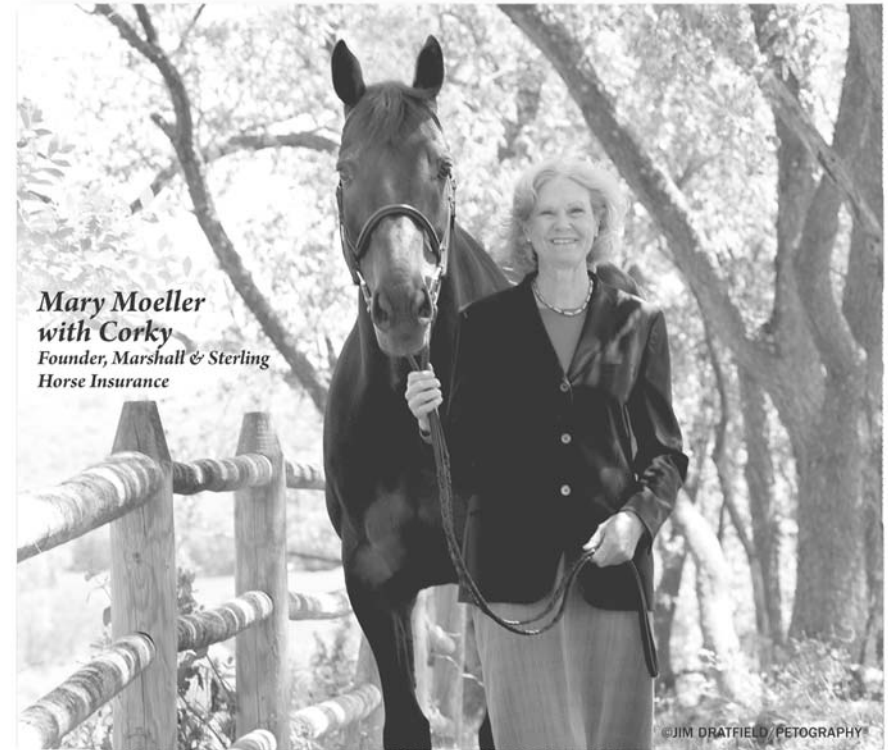

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the specifications of the current USEF Rule Book Zone II, and the LIHSAA will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. Member: Long Island Score Awards Association. All points won at this show will count toward the annual Long Island High Score Awards. In order to be eligible for an award in any LIHSAA section, the horse, pony or rider must have shown in that section in at least six member shows.
3. **ENTRIES CLOSE THE 72 HOURS PRIOR TO THE SHOW. NO PHONE ENTRIES.**
4. **NO NUMBERS WILL BE GIVEN OUT WITHOUT FEES PAID FOR IN FULL AND ENTRY BLANK SIGNED BY BOTH EXHIBITOR OR HIS AUTHORIZED AGENT AND TRAINER. THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**
5. All exhibitors in the Pony and Junior Hunter Sections must present their measurement cards at the Show Office before number may be picked up to speed processing, you may send a photostat of your card with your entry blank. All Ponies and Junior Hunters that do not have measurement cards will be measured. Time and place of measurement will be announced.
6. Classes with insufficient entries may be cancelled or combined.
7. Should any question or dispute arise that is not provided for in these Rules, the same shall be referred to the Shows Management, **WHOSE DECISION SHALL BE FINAL.**
8. Prize money will be paid by check at the secretary's stand. **Entry Fee is \$30.00 per class, unless otherwise noted. Warm-ups \$20.00 per trip. POST ENTRY FEE: \$15.00 per class.**
9. Division Championships - Will be awarded on the basis of the USEF Rules in all Hunter and Jumper divisions. Division championships will be awarded on points Hunter & Jumper 10,6,4,2,1,1/2 and Equitation 5,3,2,1. In the case of equal points, the rider with the most points over fences will be declared the Champion. In the event there is a still a tie the rider with the most points in the first class over fences will be declared Champion.
10. Approved protective head gear must be worn when riding anywhere on the grounds.
11. A rotating jumping order will be established for all over fences classes. Riders who have conflicts must see the Gateperson at each ring so that the necessary adjustments may be made. **Trainer conflicts will not be honored.**
12. Incomplete entry blanks (Blanks without all numbers & info) will be considered to be late and will be subject to post entry fees.
13. The committee reserves the right to add to or vary the list of judges if necessary.
14. Sharps container located in the secretary's stand.
15. **Checks returned unpaid will be subject to a \$50.00 service charge and any future entries will be on a cash basis only.**
16. **Show Scratch Fee \$25.**
17. Opportunity Classes- Horses entered only in these classes A. are exempt from the Federation fee, including the Equine Drugs and Medication Fee. B. are not required to have a Horse Identification (HID) or Recording Number but are to list the HID or Recording number if the horse has been assigned this number. Riders/drivers/handlers entered only in these classes are exempt from the Federation membership requirements and are not required to pay a non-member fee but are required to list the Federation membership number if the participant is a member.

LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NONMEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30 NONMEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE: 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (ACADEMY CLASSES ARE CLASSES LIMITED TO HORSES USED REGULARLY IN A LESSON PROGRAM); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS. 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES, 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION, 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

COURSES: Horses must be shown over a minimum of eight obstacles the required height in all sections. Exception: jump-off courses, High Jump, Six Bar and LIHSAA Short Stirrup.

RIDER ELIGIBILITY on PONIES: In accordance with USEF proposed rule clarification, adults may show ponies in classes that are not restricted to junior riders, however that pony may not be shown in any junior exhibitor class at the same show.

HUNTER WARM UP CLASSES: If a hunter warm-up class is to be judged, please note USEF General Rule 1510: Entering a class Hors De Concours (without being judged) is prohibited except in jumper classes, which is at management's discretion.

SHORT STIRRUP: A rider who enters and shows in the Short Stirrup Division (Equitation or Hunter) shall not be eligible to enter any other section or division at that show. Riders must be age 12 or under as of December 1 of the current show year. In order to split the section 8 are needed, at least 3 in each section. Section to be split by age. 10 and under and 11-12. [CHANGE 12/1/2009] Riders who accumulate 350 points in Short Stirrup Equitation are pointed out of the division and no longer eligible to show in this division at the end of the show year. Permissible test for the Short Stirrup Equitation is USEF Hunter Seat Equitation Test #1. (Halt and/or back). Courses for all short stirrup classes must consist of at least six (6) cross rails not to exceed 18". In the Short Stirrup Hunter Section, courses must contain 1 change of direction. Points for Short Stirrup Equitation will be accrued to bronze, silver and gold medal status as follows: Bronze Medal 85 points Silver Medal 200 points Gold Medal 350 points Combine LIHSAA PRE-CHILDRENS HUNTERS and PRE ADULT HUNTERS - allowed if one section has less than 3 entries. [NEW 2/8/2010]

LIHSAA BABY GREEN HUNTERS – Fences 2'6". Open to horses of any age in their first or second year of showing in USEF Regular Member Shows. Horses cannot cross enter into any classes at the same show where fences exceed 3'. [CHANGE 12/1/2009]

LIHSAA PRE-CHILDRENS HUNTERS: Two sections must be offered: Ponies and Horses. If there are less than 3 entries in either the Pony section or the Horse section, both sections must be combined. Ponies to jump 2' and horses to jump 2'6". A rider who enters and shows in the Pre-Children's Hunter Division must be eligible as a limit equitation rider for the current horse show year as of December 1. Riders may not cross enter into the Childrens Hunter division.

LIHSAA PRE-ADULT HUNTERS: Fences 2'3" - 2'6". Open to horses and ponies to be ridden by an adult amateur rider who has not won more than 6 blues in either the 3 foot Hunter or Equitation divisions as of December 1. Riders may not cross enter into any other division at that shows where fences are higher than 2'6".

LIHSAA PRE-MINI EQUITATION: Exhibitors must be Junior Riders who have not won three (3) blue ribbons in any 3' or higher equitation class. Riders who accumulate 250 points are pointed out of the division and no longer eligible to show in this division at the end of the show year. 1st through 6th place will receive points as 7-5-4-3-2-1. To be shown over a lower and/or modified version of the courses used in the National Medal Classes (3'6" and 3' classes). Riders may not compete in the Mini and National medal classes at the same show that they compete in the Pre-Mini Division. Points will be accrued to bronze, silver and gold medal status as follows: Bronze Medal 65 points Silver Medal 125 points Gold Medal 250 points

Combine PreMini and Adult Equitation - Allowed if one section has less than 3 entries. [NEW 12/1/2009]

LIHSAA JUMPERS: Open to horses and ponies. Fences 3' to 3'3".

LIHSAA SPECIAL HUNTERS: Open to horses. Fences 3'. No restrictions as to horse or rider, no restrictions as to cross entering.

LIHSAA LOW HUNTERS: Open to horses and ponies. Fences 2'6". Adults may show ponies in this section, but that pony may not be shown by in any class restricted to junior riders at the same show.

LIHSAA OPEN HUNTERS: Open to all horses. Shown over a course of fences no higher than 3'5".

LIHSAA ADULT EQUITATION DIVISION: Riders in the following adult equitation classes may not compete in classes where fences exceed 3'6" at the same show.

Combine PreMini and Adult Equitation - Allowed if one section has less than 3 entries. [NEW 12/1/2009]

HUGH J.B. CASSIDY III ADULT MACLAY: Open to adult amateur riders. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences at 2'6" with or without wings. A minimum of 12 riders if available is required to show at a walk, trot and canter. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of the horse. The Under Saddle shall count 50%. Test 1-19. Only one rider per horse.

ROBERT HOSKINS ADULT MEDAL: Open to adult amateur riders. To be shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles at 2'6" which must include one combination including an oxer, and two changes of direction. Two or more tests of the top four contestants are required. Tests 1-19. Only one rider per horse.

ADULT PHA: To be run in accordance with current PHA equitation rules. Rider must be a Member of the LIPHA as of the date he/she competes in an Adult PHA Medal Class in order for points to count. Fences at 2'6".

LIHSAA JUNIOR EQUITATION DIVISION

HUGH J.B. CASSIDY III JUNIOR MACLAY: Open to Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday and who have not won three (3) blue ribbons in any 3'6" or higher equitation class prior to the closing date for entries for this show. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight obstacles not exceeding 3' with or without wings. A minimum of 12 riders if available is required to show at a walk, trot and canter. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of the horse. The Under Saddle performance of those riders selected to show under saddle shall count 50%. Tests 1-19. Only one rider per horse.

ROBERT HOSKINS JUNIOR MEDAL: Open to Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday and who have not won three (3) blue ribbons in any 3'6" or higher equitation class prior to the closing date for entries for this show. To be shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles not exceeding 3' which must include a combination including an oxer, and two changes of direction. Two or more tests of the top four contestants are required. Tests 1-19. Only one rider per horse.

MINI PHA: To be run in accordance with current PHA equitation rules. Rider must be a Junior Member of the LIPHA as of the date he/she competes in a Mini PHA Medal Class in order for points to count. Fences not to exceed 3'.

2010 Zone II Specifications

In accordance with GR 1111.4: Contiguous states are DE, CT, MA, VT, MD, WV & OH.

Adult Amateur Hunter: To be shown by riders 18 years and older who hold current USEF Amateur certification. Ponies may be shown in this division, with suitability taken into consideration by the judge. Riders may not compete in any other classes at the same competition where the fence height exceeds 3'6", except Adult Amateur Jumper. Horses may be shown by a different rider in any other division or class at the same competition. **Riders may cross enter between the Adult Hunter and the Amateur Owner division if the rider owns the horse he or she is showing in the Adult Amateur division. Riders can cross enter between the Amateur Owner 3'3" and 3'6", but horses may not cross enter between the Adult Amateur and Amateur Owner Hunter sections at the same show.** If the division is held in one day a maximum of four classes may be offered. If the division is held over two days a maximum of five classes may be offered. This division may be split into three age groups – Adult Amateurs 18-35 and Adult Amateurs 36-49 and Adult Amateurs 50 and over. If there are less than three entries in one Adult division if offered split it may be combined with another Adult Amateur division. If there is only one section of Adult Amateurs it may be combined with the Children's Hunter Horse division. Fence height to be 3' with spreads not to exceed fence height. Horses must have current recording with the USEF to accrue points. Horses not to jog.

Children's Hunter: To be shown by a junior exhibitor. Rider may not cross enter into any other class at the same competition where the fences exceed 3' except Children's Jumper, and Equitation Classes where the fences do not exceed 3'6". A rider on a Children's Hunter Horse may cross enter into the Pony Hunter Division or the Green Pony Hunter Division at the same competition, but a rider on a Children's Hunter Pony may NOT cross enter into the Pony Hunter Division or Green Pony Hunter at the same competition. Horses may not cross enter into the Junior Hunter Division at the same competition. If the division is held in one day, a maximum of 4 classes may be offered, if the division is held over two days, a maximum of 5 classes may be offered. The Children's Hunter Division may be split into four sections, points will be accrued separately for each section, and Zone Awards will be given for each section. The sections are to be: Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under, Children's Hunter Horse 15-17, Children's Hunter Large Pony and Children's Hunter Small/Medium Pony. If there are more than 25 in any one section then that section may be split into Sections A and B. **If there are less than 3 horses entered in the Children's Hunter Horse Division, then they may be combined and judged with the Adult Amateur Hunter Division. If there are less than 3 ponies in the Children's Hunter Small/Medium Pony or Children's Hunter Large Pony, then the classes may be combined and judged together.** Fence heights are to be 3' for Children's Horses, 2'6" for Children's Large Pony, and 2' for Children's Small/Medium Pony, with spreads not to exceed fence height. Horses must have current recording with the USEF to accrue points.

Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter Classic: Any competition which offers an Adult Amateur Hunter or a Children's Hunter section may also offer an Adult Amateur Classic and/or a Children's Hunter Classic in accordance with HU 145, with the following exceptions; 1.) Bonus points for Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be awarded as follows: 1st - 20, 2nd - 16, 3rd - 14, 4th - 12, 5th - 10, 6th - 8, 7th - 6, 8th - 5, 9th - 4, 10th - 3, 11th - 2, 12th - 1 2.) Classics must offer at least \$500 in prize money; 3.) Height and spread of fences to be the same as there requirements for the respective section; 4.) Riders are not required to wear special attire as described in HU146.5 but must wear protective headgear in accordance with GR 801. All current Zone 2 eligibility requirements must be met.

Children's Jumpers: To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1 of the current competition year. Fence heights to be set between 1.0m (3'3") and 1.15m (3'9"). Riders may not compete in any other class at the same competition where fences exceed 1.15m (3'9") except the USEF Talent Search Class. Horses may show at 1.40m (4'7") or below with another rider. Cash winnings do not influence this classification. Sections and/or prize money, if offered, may be divided and/or combined with the Adult Amateur Jumpers at the discretion of management.

Adult Amateur Jumpers: To be ridden by exhibitors who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. All exhibitors must be Amateurs in accordance with GR 1306 and must show USEF Amateur Certification. Fence heights to be set between 1.0m (3'3") and 1.15m (3'9"). Riders may not compete in any other class at the same competition where fences exceed 1.15m (3'9") except the USEF Talent Search Class. Horses may show at 1.40m (4'7") or below with another rider. Cash winnings do not influence this classification. Sections and/or prize money, if offered, may be divided and/or combined with the Children's Jumpers at the discretion of management.

Pre-Green Hunter: A pre-green hunter is a horse of any age in its first two consecutive years of showing that has never shown over fences 3'6" or higher. Fence height not to exceed 3'3". Horses may not cross enter any division where the fences are 3'6" or higher at the same competition. To be judged on performance, soundness and way of going. Horses not to jog. There will not be a Zone year end award for this division. Horses that are otherwise eligible may return to pregreen after a first year green reinstatement.
