RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. NO NUMBERS WILL BE GIVEN OUT WITHOUT FEES PAID IN FULL AND ENTRY BLANK SIGNED BY BOTH EXHIBITOR OR AUTHORIZED AGENT AND TRAINER. THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.
2. Classes with insufficient entries may be cancelled or combined.
3. Should any question or dispute arise which is not provided for in these rules, same shall be referred to Show Management, WHOSE DECISION SHALL BE FINAL.
4. Division Championships- Division Championships shall be awarded on the following basis in all Hunter and Jumper divisions. Division championships will be awarded on points: Hunter and Jumper 10,6,4,2,1 and ½ and Equitation 5,3,2,1. In the case of equal points, the rider with the most points over fences will be declared Champion. In the event, there is still a tie, the rider with the most points in the first class over fences will be declared Champion.
5. Approved headgear must be worn when riding anywhere on the showgrounds.
6. A rotating jumper order will be established for all over fences classes. Riders who have conflicts must see the Gateperson at each ring so that necessary adjustments can be made.
7. Horse Show Management reserves the right to add or vary the list of judges as necessary.
8. Checks returned unpaid will be subject to a \$50.00 service charge and any future entries will be on a cash-only basis.
9. Every animal entered for competition or on the show grounds shall be subject to control of Show Management.
10. Winner's Circle Horse Show, Inc., its officers, and /or employees shall not be liable or responsible for any loss, damage or claim to any person, animal or property for any reason during the competition and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor release and hold harmless Winner's Circle Horse Show, its officers, and /or its employees from any action or claim arising therefrom.
11. Entries will close 24 hours prior to show.

AWARDS

The Winner's Circle Schooling Shows series will offer series-end championships in all divisions with all ribbons and awards to be presented at the August 4th show. In order to be eligible for these series-end championships, riders must compete in both shows in the series.

These shows are also 2010 USHJA Outreach Competitions and will feature four USHJA Equitation Medal Classes as listed. All exhibitors may compete in these classes without USEF or USHJA membership requirements, but for points to count toward the USHJA Equitation Medal Awards, exhibitors need to be either Outreach Members or Regular Members of USHJA. The Outreach membership is available for a \$15.00 annual fee.
